I would like to commend all of you for your continued dedication to our program! I would like to take our Pack Leadership to the next level. While we are all **Trained** Leaders, I would like many of you to consider additional training to add to your skill set. There are a couple of ways that this can be accomplished.

The first is to go to Round Table Meetings. These meetings are the second Tuesday of the month. Typically the start time is 7:30pm and the location is at the Glen Landing Middle School. Many of the Cub Scout leaders from our District attend this meeting and most love to share their experiences and provide support for many of the interests a Cub Scout Leader may have in their role in the Pack. I have provided a QR code at the bottom of this page that will link you to the District's Calendar of events so you can easily access the date and time.

The second way is to attend either BALOO or ITOLS training. BALOO (Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation) training covers the basics of camping in the Cub Scout realm. If you have never participated in an outdoor event with the Pack, I recommend going to the training. Even if you are a seasoned veteran, you may pick up another nugget of knowledge to add to your collection. If you have completed BALOO training and/or are a Webelos/Arrow of Light leader I suggest ITOLS (Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills) training. This training is to increase your outdoor skills and also how to teach them to our Cub Scouts.
